Gold posts 1st weekly gain since May as US Fed rate hike fears ease

Mumbai, July 4 (IANS) Gold recorded its first weekly gain since May as trader expectations for further US Federal Reserve rate hikes moderated, pushing bullion prices around 3.1 per cent for the week. Soft US job numbers and lower energy prices led to investors reducing the expectations of monetary policy tightening. However, on Friday, MCX gold August futures

eased 0.01 per cent while MCX silver July futures inched up 0.04 per cent. Currently, gold futures stand at Rs 1,47,365, while silver futures at Rs 2,37,499 per kg.

The price of 10 grams of 24-carat gold was at Rs 1,46,344 on Friday, up from Rs 1,41,911 seen on Monday market opening, according to data published by the India Bullion and Jew-

ellers Association (IBJA). "Gold extended its recovery for the fourth consecutive session and touched a 10-day high on Friday. The rebound comes after more than a month of sustained selling following the May 13 import duty hike, with improving sentiment supported by a softer US dollar," an analyst said.

The analyst said that the recent pullback in the Dollar Index has encouraged fresh buying in bullion, and forecasted that the bullion is expected to trade in the Rs 1,45,000-1,49,000 range, with global cues continuing to drive sentiment. Market participants said softer US labour data and easing energy costs reduced the probability of further Fed tightening.

US hiring slowed sharply in June and traders trimmed the probability of a quarter-point rate increase at the Fed's next meeting to below 20 per cent, down from roughly one-third earlier in the week. Lower energy costs and softer job growth have led analysts to forecast a gradual easing of inflationary pressures in coming months.

Centre hikes onion procurement price by 13 pc to Rs 2,125 per quintal

New Delhi, July 4 (IANS) The government on Saturday said it has increased the procurement price of onions by 13 per cent to Rs 2,125 per quintal from Rs 1,875 per quintal, effective from today, thus ensuring better returns for onion farmers and strengthening buffer procurement. The Consumer Affairs Ministry said that procurement of onions through NAFED and NCCF for the government's Price Stabilisation Buffer is in progress.

The revised procurement price will ensure better returns for onion farmers while supporting buffer procurement efforts, said the ministry.

Onion production is estimated at 307.37 lakh metric tonnes (LMT) for 2025-26, according to the second advance estimates of the Department of Agriculture & Farmers' Welfare, which is comparable to the

production of 307.67 LMT in 2024-25.

Going by the production estimates, the overall availability of onions is not a concern at this stage, though prices may be expected to inch up in line with the normal price seasonality, said the ministry.

"Current stock levels in Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh and Gujarat are adequate. At present, there are no indications of any shortage of stored onions," it added. Moreover, daily mandi arrivals at the all-India level remain robust at over 50,000 metric tonnes (MT), while arrivals in Maharashtra are over 30,000 MT, with average modal prices of about Rs 18 per kg. Better-quality stocks continue to remain in storage and are expected to be released during the lean period. The all-India average retail price is Rs 31 per kg.

Onion exports are also

normal, with about 1.50 LMT exported during June.

However, traders expect that the pace of onion exports may slow down for a short duration, primarily because fresh crops from Pakistan and China are available at competitive rates in key export destinations such as the Gulf countries, Sri Lanka and the Far East. While the Nashik region of Maharashtra has reported about a 15-day delay in Kharif sowing, the sowing progress in the Chitradurga and Challakere belt of Karnataka is estimated to be around 60 per cent of normal, according to the government.

Mega development projects are for future, not approval ratings: Lee

Seoul, July 4 (IANS) South Korean President Lee Jae Myung on Saturday rejected criticism by opposition sides that the government's large-scale regional investment drive is aimed at boosting his approval ratings, saying the three "megaprojects" are designed to create new hope and a future for the country. Earlier this week, the government unveiled its "three megaprojects" initiative, which envisions a national transformation driven by semi-conductors, physical artificial intelligence (AI) and AI data centres, calling for a total investment of 4,755 trillion won (US\$3.11 trillion), reports Yonhap news agency. As part of the scheme, Samsung announced plans to build two memory chip fabrication plants in the southwestern city of Gwangju, while SK hynix said it will construct two fabs in the surrounding Jeolla provinces under a combined investment plan worth 800 trillion won.

"If the projects had been intended to manage approval ratings, they would have been launched ahead of the June 3 local elections," Lee said in a post on X, adding that such a national transformation plan was something he had long dreamed of ven before taking office.

India's auto demand remains resilient in June: Report

New Delhi, July 4 (IANS) Auto sector demand in India remained resilient in June, with personal mobility segments continuing to outperform, a report has said. The report from Asit C Mehta Investment Intermediates said easing of supply-side bottlenecks at several OEMs, healthy retail demand and sustained export momentum supported volume growth during June. Export momentum for two- and three-wheelers is also expected to remain supportive, the report added. Two-wheeler YoY retail growth rate accelerated across all players for June, compared to slightly slower traction seen in May 2026, while wholesale growth was mixed across OEMs

"June 2026 remained another healthy month for the domestic auto industry, with demand holding up well across all segments despite macro and geopolitical risks and price hikes," the brokerage said. Retail demand was supported by healthy consumer sentiment, while exports maintained strong momentum across most OEMs. "Overall, demand remained resilient despite concerns around fuel prices, inflationary pressures and monsoon uncertainty," it noted. For commercial vehicles, retail traction did not show high growth, but wholesale growth was very strong across OEMs for the month, with improving infrastructure activity, replacement demand and export recovery being major positives. Tractor demand should remain supported through H1FY27 on a favourable base, while monsoon progression and weather risks remain the key variables for H2, the firm forecasted.
